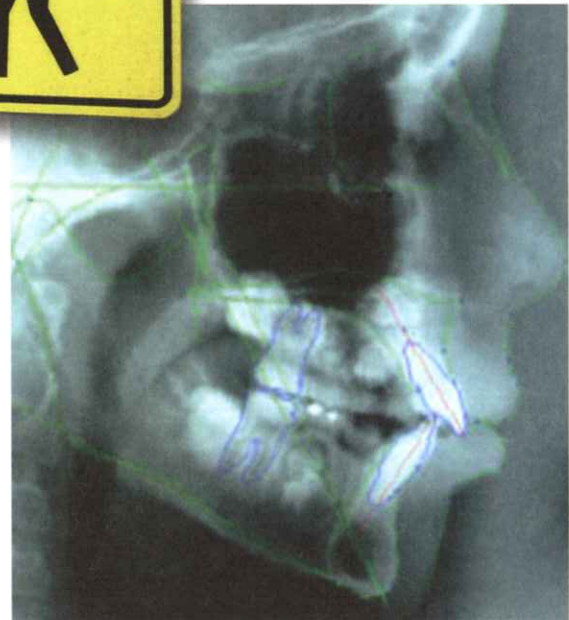
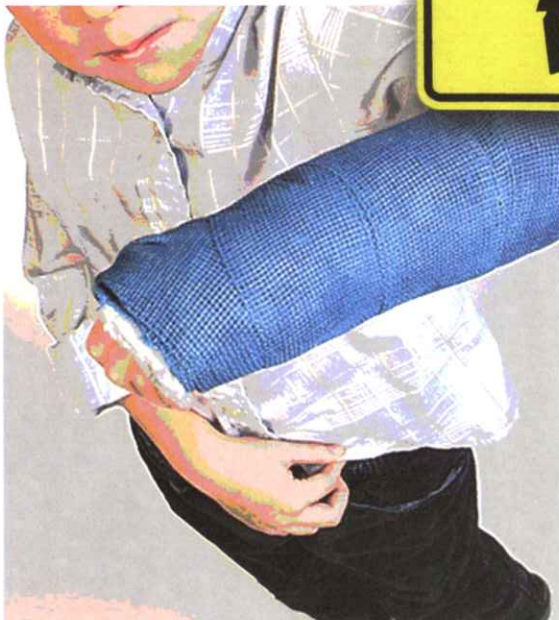
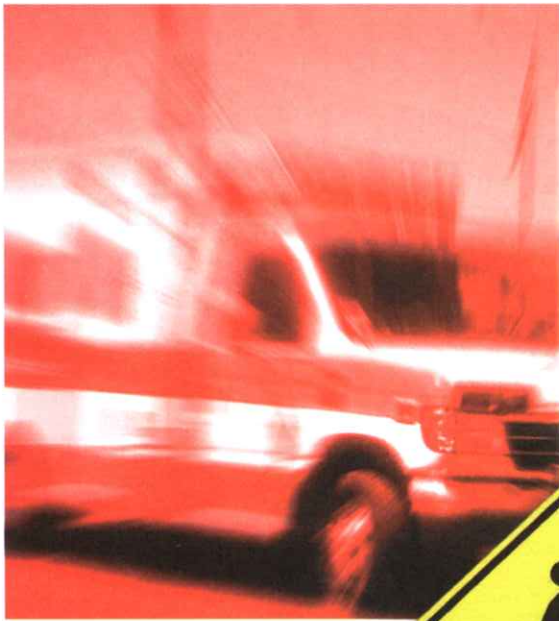

Basic coverage

Every eligible child attending public school in Nova Scotia is automatically insured by the School Insurance Program's Basic student accident coverage. This coverage is provided without a deductible and at no cost to students, parents/guardians or schools. Basic coverage is provided to cover students during school hours, school activities and travel to and from their school.

Who is eligible?

All full-time pre-primary, primary, elementary, junior and senior high public school students and attendees at school board day-care centres in the province of Nova Scotia who are covered under a Canadian federal and/or provincial health and hospitalization insurance plan are eligible. Please note that university, private school, private day-care, community colleges and foreign students, etc. are not eligible.
